Eligibility:

Candidates must be **enrolled undergraduate students** when applying for their scholarship (*incoming freshmen are not eligible, and current students cannot be in professional training*). Pre-veterinary students normally will be considered after completing approximately 30 hours of coursework at OSU. Emphasis will be given to candidates who have proven their academic ability in more difficult courses and who have a GPA compatible with being accepted to veterinary school; **a GPA of 3.0 or higher is required**. Transfer students are encouraged to apply but must be attending OSU when their application is considered.

The following **MUST** be included for your application to be considered:

- Unofficial transcript (OSU and any transfer coursework)
- Two letters of recommendation must be sent to Dodi Reesman at the address below by the deadline.
